Brenda Kay Smallwood Purtlebaugh, age 60, passed away on December 29, 2020 after her courageous battle with Covid-19.

Brenda was raised in Winchester, having graduated from John Handley High School in 1979. Throughout her lifetime, she maintained employment at several locations including Amoco Foam, Leer Corporation, JC Penney and most recently Lowes Home Improvement.

Brenda enjoyed gardening and her green thumb was evident from her immaculate yard at her home in Inwood, West Virginia. When she wasn't gardening, she was mostly likely backstage at a Shiley Acres music festival or listening to other local rock and metal bands in the area with her select group of friends.

She helped spay and neuter stray cats in her area and set up warming shelters in the winter for the neighborhood strays.
