Edison George "Zero" Hamilton, 69, of Stephens City, VA passed away Thursday, July 19, 2018 in Novant Hospital, Haymarket, VA.

Mr. Hamilton was born April 22, 1949 in Norton, Wise County, VA the son of Edison and Gladys Maines Hamilton.

He was a graduate of James Wood High School class of 1968 and then graduated on August 16, 1968 from the United States Marine Corps, platoon 378 and served with the Marine Corps. He also attended Lord Fairfax Community College.
