Eleanor Joyce Miller Estep, 91, of Stephens City departed for her Heavenly Home Sunday, September 3, 2017 surrounded by her family singing hymns and loving her.

She was born August 15, 1926 in Clarke County to the late Arthur Burwell Lee and Emily Reynolds Lee.

After graduation from Berryville High School, she began working at McCoy's Department Store in Harrisonburg, VA. Later she began secretarial work at National Fruit corporate offices in the Old Winchester Hotel.

Eleanor married Harrison Levi Miller of Winchester, VA October 9, 1944 after he was wounded in action and sent home. They became deeply rooted in their Christian Faith and began prayer meetings in their home. This humble beginning was the start of the Winchester Church of God. They soon entered the ministry as her husband became ordained. Harrison served as pastor of Manassas COG, Timberville COG, and Bassett COG. He also organized and started the Harrisonburg Church of God until his death in 1965.

Eleanor remarried Carl W. Estep in 1970. Together they operated New Market Feed & Hardware / True Value until his passing in 2010. Eleanor later Leased the hardware store and moved to Winchester to live with her son. All who knew her, loved her.
