



## Ellin Jelinek Peters

August 31, 1939 - July 20, 2017

Ellin Jelinek Peters, 77, of Winchester died Thursday, July 20, 2017 in her residence.

She was born August 31, 1939 in Pozdzenice, Poland the daughter of Josef and Alma Seidlitz Jelinek. She grew up in Germany, where she met and married Carl H. Peters, Jr. on July 18, 1959. They moved to Raleigh, NC, and then later to Sterling, VA. They were married for 24 years. Mr. Peters preceded her in death.
