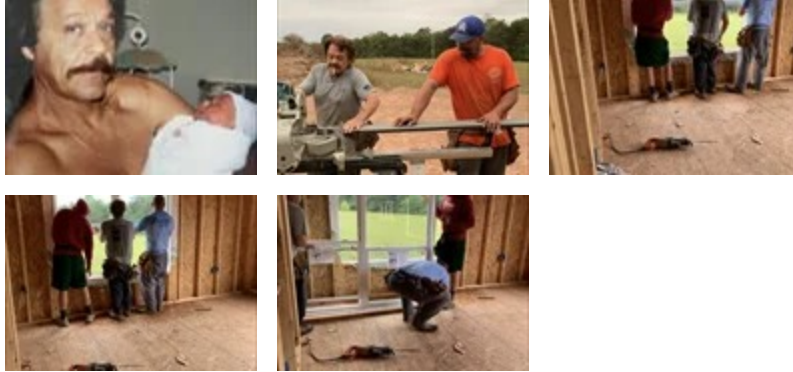
In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sisters Gloria Newlin and Rose Rinker and brother Harvey Pitcock.

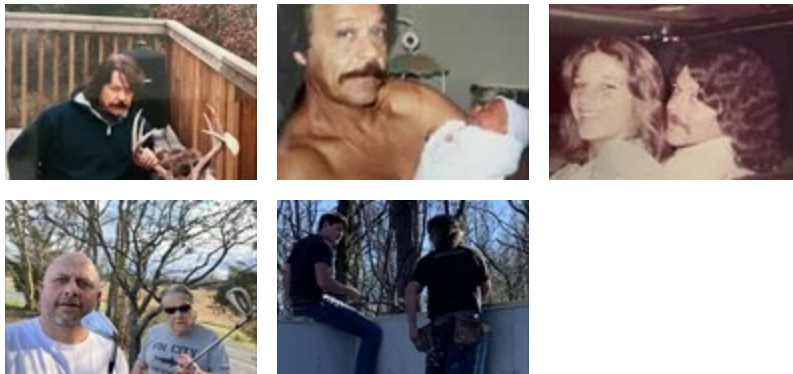
