Louis Dixon Eye, II, 79, of Stephens City passed away peacefully Friday, June 23, 2023 in his residence with loving family around him.

He was born May 4, 1944 in Milford, DE the son of Louis and Vivian Violet Eye.

"Louie" graduated from James Wood High School in 1962. Following that, he served in the US Air Force for 4 years. Professionally, he worked at Mount Weather for AT&T where he retired in 1999, and then FEMA in 2006.
