Stephen Mitchell Day, 65, of Rappahannock County, died after a long illness on Friday, August 31, 2012 at Loving Arms Assisted Living in Front Royal with his sister, Lisa at his bedside.

He was predeceased by his parents, Eileen Mitchell Day and Walter Owens Day and by his son, Dugald. Stephen is survived by his daughter, Lily Day of Ocracoke, NC and by his brothers and sisters: Margy, Robin, Donal, Vincent, Kevin, Lisa, Maureen and Johanna and by 14 nieces and nephews.

Stephen was born on March 10, 1947 in Quantico, Virginia and graduated from Fauquier High School in 1966. He served in the US Army and lived much of his life in Rappahannock County. At his peak, he was a formidable personality known for his quick mind, sharp wit and attractive character. Stephen made friends easily and showered them with his attention.

He had a varied career. Starting out in computer operations in the 1970's, he later designed databases for the World Bank and the Howard Hughes Medical Institute, and he ended his work life creating web sites. Additionally, he built barns, made furniture and dabbled in real estate.

His greatest sources of pride were his children and the fact that he was part of a large and loyal clan. His greatest loss was the untimely death of his son.

It was impossible not to love Stephen and his family is deeply saddened.
